



Steps on how to complete our “Virtual Screening” online:

NOTE:

THIS IS NOT A ZOOM CALL NOR REAL TIME APPOINTMENT!

- 1) Go to our website at www.hobokenortho.com
- 2) Allow **90** seconds for a **pop-up** that says:
Receive a Virtual Screening from an Orthodontist!
- 3) Click on **START NOW**
- 4) Continue to follow the steps to submit photos.
 - I. **RETAINER PATIENTS**, please take pictures of your smile and teeth with your retainers on and without them on.
 - II. **INVISALIGN PATIENTS**, please take pictures of your smile and teeth with your last aligners on and without them on.
 - III. **EXPANDER PATIENTS**, you are considered ‘braces treatment’, please take **CLEAR** pictures of the expander and the roof of your mouth.
 - IV. **BRACES PATIENTS**, please take **CLEAR** pictures of your smile and bite.
 - V. **COMFORT CHECKS**, please take **CLEAR** pictures of the area that needs comfort, provide details of how this occurred and specify if there is any pain or discomfort so we can properly accommodate.

5) **As previously stated, please be informed neither your presence nor real time are required for this visit. Doctors will review submission and evaluate with next steps within 24-48 hours.**

6) **Photos must be submitted by 8 am the day of your appointment, photos submitted after this time will be rescheduled and will be considered a NO-SHOW.**

We recommend you submit photos 2-3 days before your appointment.

7) To access your account, you must use the link that is emailed to you by **'Ortho Screening Kit'**. Please ensure to check your spam/junk email if you do not receive the link. The password you use to create your account will be the continuous password.

You will need to remember this password to log back in.

9) You can feel free to ask Doctor questions in the chat box online or request a phone call. The chat box/ messenger box is a great way to communicate with doctors which is consistently being monitored.
